Student Participation Agreement and Release

As a condition of participating in the Los Angeles Master Chorale’s 2024 High School Choir Festival – to be held at Walt Disney Concert Hall on May 3, 2024 – I agree to the terms of this agreement, through which I grant my permission to use my child’s name, likeness and voice in audio and video recordings, still photographs and all other forms of media. This permission covers all rehearsals and preparatory sessions, in addition to the performance at the event itself.

I understand that the Los Angeles Master Chorale (hereafter, “Master Chorale or LAMC”) may use various media for educational and publicity purposes. The Master Chorale may use a broad array of media formats, including, but not limited to, audio, video, film, CD or other mediums, whether in existence now or developed in the future. The Master Chorale may use this media in connection with public and private events, for educational, instructional, training, publicity, or demonstration purposes. Also, the Master Chorale may use the media for exhibition or sale. It is likely the Master Chorale will distribute media gathered at and in preparation for the 2024 High School Choir Festival to schools and the general public.

I hereby release the Master Chorale from any liability or obligation to compensate me for my child’s participation and appearance in its 2024 High School Choir Festival, including for the purposes described in the preceding paragraph. I agree that being allowed to participate in said High School Choir Festival is fair compensation for all of the rights released herein.

Furthermore, I release the Master Chorale, The Music Center of Los Angeles County, the County of Los Angeles, Walt Disney Concert Hall and their employees, from any and all liability of all kind and type, whether contractual or otherwise, arising from my participation in the High School Choir Festival.
